Suggested activities:

- Ask students to become animators and read the texts on the factsheets out loud, and then ask them to comment on what they read.



IT'S A MUST

VISITING PARC SAFARI ON FOOT AND ON BOARD VEHICLE

VISIT THE SAFARI ADVENTURE ABOARD...

your bus or a bush truck

Some 300 animals, belonging to 30 different species, roam freely on the prairie of the Safari Adventure. Aboard your vehicle, or the bush truck, you will see from up close elephants, greater kudus, gnus, onagers, water buffalo, gaurs, dromaderies. On safari, you will encounter herds of spectacular animals.

Suggested activities:

- Name an animal that originates from Africa, from Europe, from Asia and from America.
- Name the largest species of antelope, as well as the smallest.
- Which quadruped loves to spend the day in water?
- Why is the dromedary so well adapted to a desert climate?



THE CHEETAHS PLAINS

While crossing the 260 meters walkway over their enclosure, discover graceful felines that sound just like small birds, but also purr like your cat. Parc Safari has 11 cheetahs, six of which are not related. This contributes to improving the genetic pool of this species that is in danger of extinction. The cheetah is the fastest land animal. This graceful runner accelerates from 0 to 100 km in 3.6 seconds.

Suggested activities:

- Compare the fur of a cheetah, a tiger and a lion.
- Identify the different colors of the cheetah, what do they sound like?
- How does the cheetah run so fast?
- What allows the cheetah to run so fast?
- In which country of Africa did Parc Safari re-introduce?



THE AFRIKA TERRACE – THE PLAINS OF AFRICA

Explore the Afrika Terrace and observe the savanna at giraffe height. Located between the elephants' enclosure and the Plains of Africa, the Afrika Terrace is a 725 square meters geographical map of Africa. On this spectacular map you will find 20 illustrations of african wonders, natural and manmade. Locate the borders and the equator, identify the countries and the great lakes of Africa.

Suggested activities:

- Which animals do you see from the Afrika Terrace?
- Name the country where the Victoria Falls are located.
- Identify two African countries in the North, the South, the East and the West.
- Which African countries are by the Mediterranean? By the Red Sea? By the Indian Ocean? By the Atlantic Ocean?



THE DEER TRAIL

As you walk through a pine and spruce forest, you will be greeted by the magnificent European fallow deer.

Suggested activities:

- Name the different species of the deer family.
- Indicate their country of origin.
- The bucks are recognizable by their antlers: count the number of bucks roaming along the trail.



FARM OF THE FIVE CONTINENTS

Discover several species that are useful to humans. Many have been domesticated and contribute to lighten people's workload. Others, in the wild, contribute to the circle of life.

Suggested activities:

- On the Inca Wall, identify the symbols of one of the ancient civilizations of the Andes.
- Which one is bigger, the lama or the alpaca?
- Make a list of the countries from which the animals of the Farm come from.
- Camel and dromedary: which one has two humps? Which one comes from Asia?
- Name some species that contribute to human nutrition.



THE OLDUVAI ELEVATED WALKWAY

The walkway overlooks the enclosures of the spotted hyenas, the arctic wolves, the macaques and the black bears. All these animals behave very differently. Watch them closely in order to identify their particular behavioural characteristics.

Suggested activities:

- Name four species that you have observed from the Olduvai Walkway .
- We have many wild species at the Parc. Name one.
- What country do hyenas come from?
- How do hyenas feed in the wild?
- True or False: During winter, black bears go into a deep sleep.



THE FELINES TUNNEL

A 19-millimetre pane of glass is all that separates you from the king of the savanna and the largest feline in the world. Parc Safari built the glass tunnel, a very impressive structure, to allow you to see from up close these majestic felines: tawny lions, white lions and Siberian tigers.

Suggested activities:

- Draw a map of Africa and Asia, and indicate where the tigers and lions live.
- Which animals are carnivorous, herbivorous, frugivorous?
- Name the biggest feline species.
- In general, felines do not like water, but there is at least one species that can swim, which one?



THE BIRD GARDEN

See the birds of prey aviary: hawks, eagles, falcons and owls

Suggested activities:

- Which bird is the fastest?
- Which bird do we find on 5 continents?



THE DISCOVERY PAVILION

Breathtakingly beautiful, discover an exceptional collection of minerals, rocks and fossils, that track the origin of life on Earth. Quebec's rich soil and underground is a true treasure trove.

Without minerals, there would be no life on earth!

Suggested activities:

- Name a gemstone
- Identify two (2) minerals
- Fossils are being studied primarily for what?
