In the animal sectors, factsheets allow our guests to learn facts that are easy to remember.

Suggested activities:

 Ask students to become animators and read the text on the factsheets out loud, and then ask them to comment on what they read.



IT'S A MUST

ON FOOT AND IN A VEHICLE

VISITING THE SAFARI ADVENTURE ON...

With your bus or on an electric bush truck.

Some 300 animals, from 30 species roam freely on the prairie of the Safari Adventure. Aboard your vehicle, or on an electric bush truck, you will see "close up" greater kudus, gnus, onagers, water buffalo, gaurs, dromaderies. On safari, you will encounter herds of spectacular animals.

Suggested activities:

- Name an animals that originate from Africa, from Europe, from Asia and from America.
- Name the largest species of antelope, as well as the smallest.
- Which quadruped loves to spend the day in water?
- Why is the dromedary so well adapted to a desert climate?

THE CHEETAHS PLAINS

While crossing the 260 meters walkway over their vast pasture, discover graceful felines that sound just like small birds, but also purr like your cat. Parc Safari has 11 cheetahs, six of which are not related. This contributes to improving the genetic pool of this species that is in danger of extinction. Parc Safari participates in conservation programs and reintroduced two cheetah in a natural reserve in Zimbabwe.

Suggested activities:

- Describe the markings of the fur of a cheetah, a tiger and a lion.
- Which animal does the call of the cheetah resembles?
- What allows the cheetah to run so fast?
- In which African country did Parc Safari re-introduce cheetahs?



THE AFRIKA TERRACE - THE PLAINS OF AFRICA

Explore the Afrika Terrace, stare giraffes eyeball to eyeball and look down at the herds roaming the savanna. This map is located on the plain of Afrika. It is 725 square meter is in the exact shape of the African continent.

Suggested activities:

- Which animals do you see from the Afrika Terrace?
- Name the country where the Victoria Falls are located.
- Identify two African countries in the North, the South, the East and the West.
- Which African countries are by the Mediterranean? By the Red Sea? By the Indian Ocean? By the Atlantic Ocean?



THE DEER TRAIL

As you walk through a pine and spruce forest, you will be greeted by the magnificent European fallow deer.

Suggested activities:

- Name the different species of the deer family.
- Indicate their country of origin.



FIVE CONTINENTS ANIMAL FARM

Discover several species that are useful to humans. Many have been domesticated and contribute to lighten people's workload. Others, in the wild, contribute to the circle of life.

Suggested activities:

- Identify two symbols etched on the Inca wall.
- Which one is bigger, the lama or the alpaca?
- Make a list of the countries from which the animals of the Farm come from.
- Camel and dromedary: which one has two humps?
 Which one comes from Asia?
- Name some species that contribute to human nutrition.



THE OLDUVAI ELEVATED WALKWAY

This 300 meter long footbridge looks down the enclosure of the spotted hyenas, the artic wolves, the macaques and the black bears. These animals behave very differently: watch them and note some aspects of their behavioural characteristics.

Suggested activities:

- Name species that you have observed from the Olduvai Walkway .
- We have many wild species at the Parc. Name one.
- What country do hyenas come from?
- How do hyenas feed in the wild?
- True or False: During winter, black bears go into a deep sleep.



THE FELINE'S GLASS TUNNEL

19-millimetre glass is all that separates you from the king of the savanna and the largest feline in the world. Walking in the glass tunnel allows you to observe these majestic felines: tawny lion, white lion.

Suggested activities:

- Draw a map of Africa and Asia, and indicate where the tigers and lions live.
- Which animals are carnivorous, herbivorous, frugivorous?
- Name the biggest feline species.
- In general, felines do not like water, but there is one that can swim, name it.



THE BIRD GARDEN

See the birds of prey aviary: hawks, eagles, falcons and owls.

Suggested activities:

- Which bird is the fastest?
- Which bird species do we find on all 5 continents?



THE DISCOVERY PAVILION

This natural science museum is breathtakingly beautiful. It present an exceptional collection of minerals, rocks, meteorites and millennial fossils which trace the footsteps of the appearence of life on earth, 4.2 billions years ago.

Suggested activities:

- Name a gemstone.
- Identify two (2) minerals.
- Fossils are being studied primarily for what?
